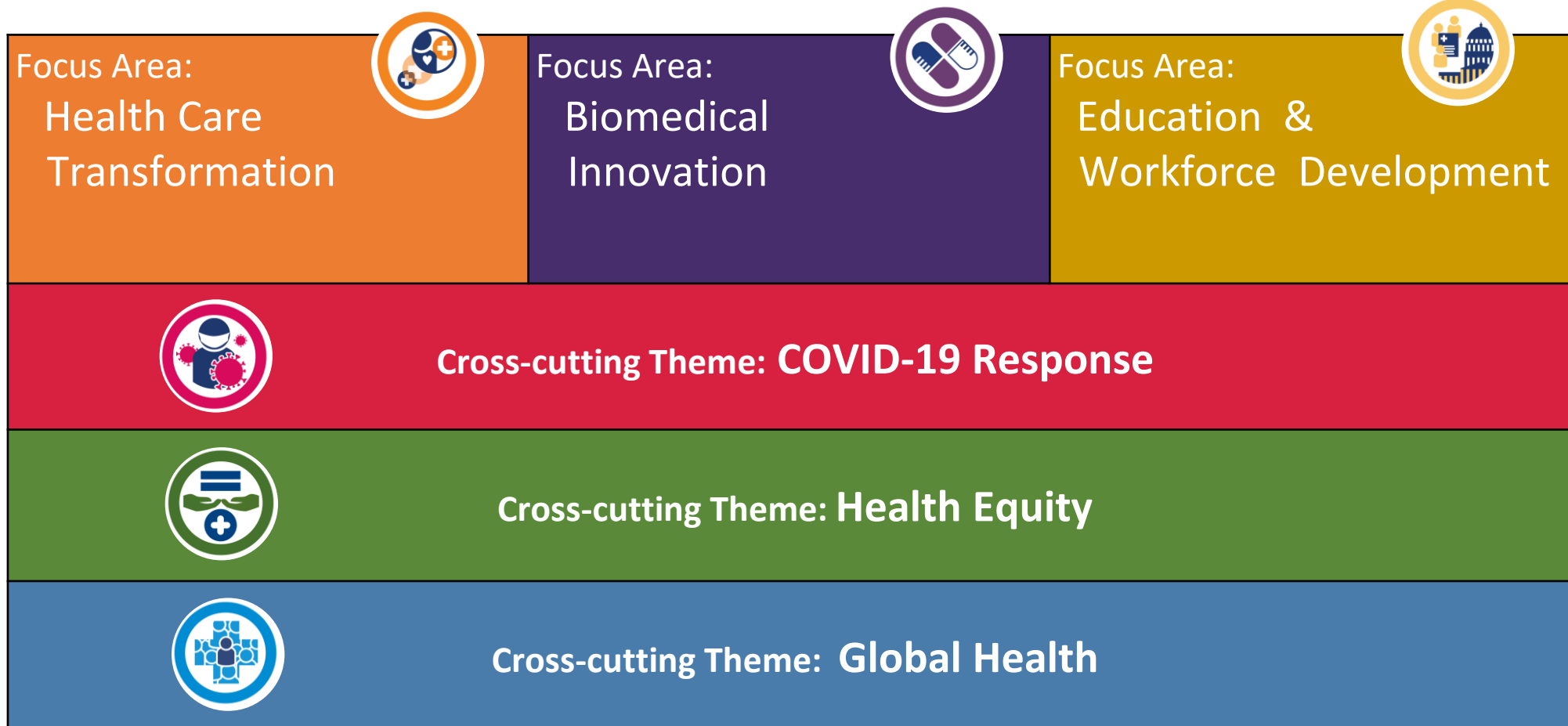
Mission

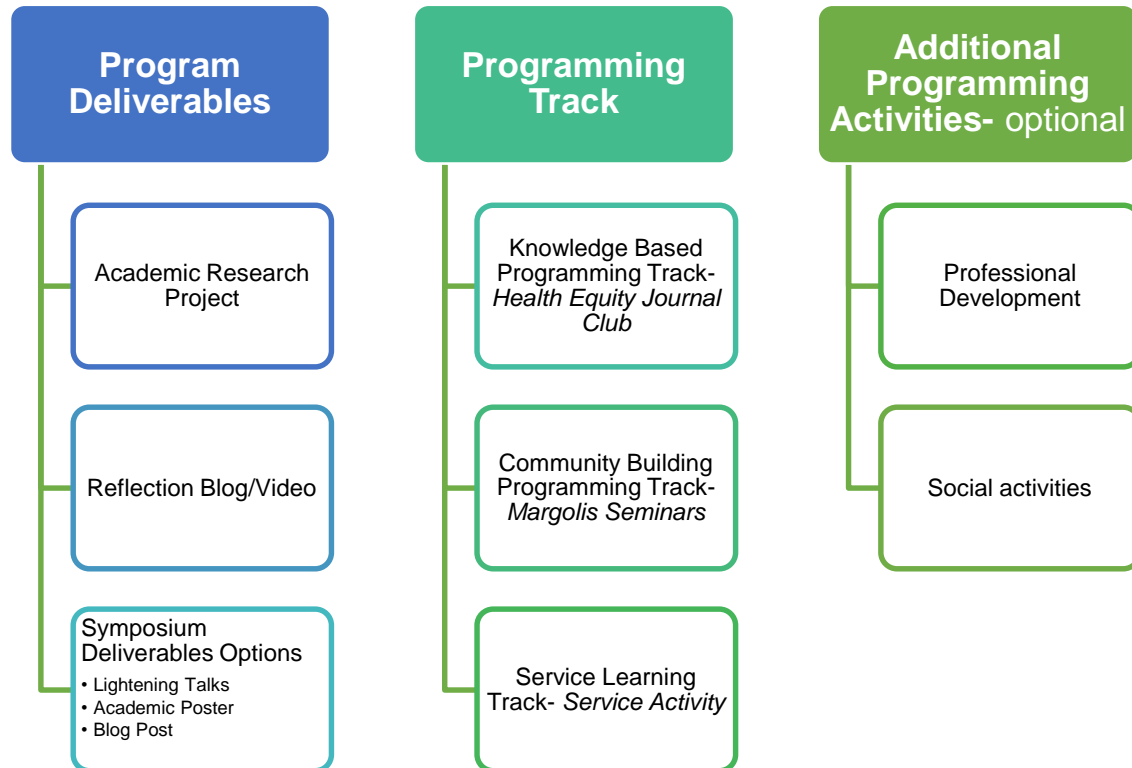
Program Objectives

Sample Intern Pathway



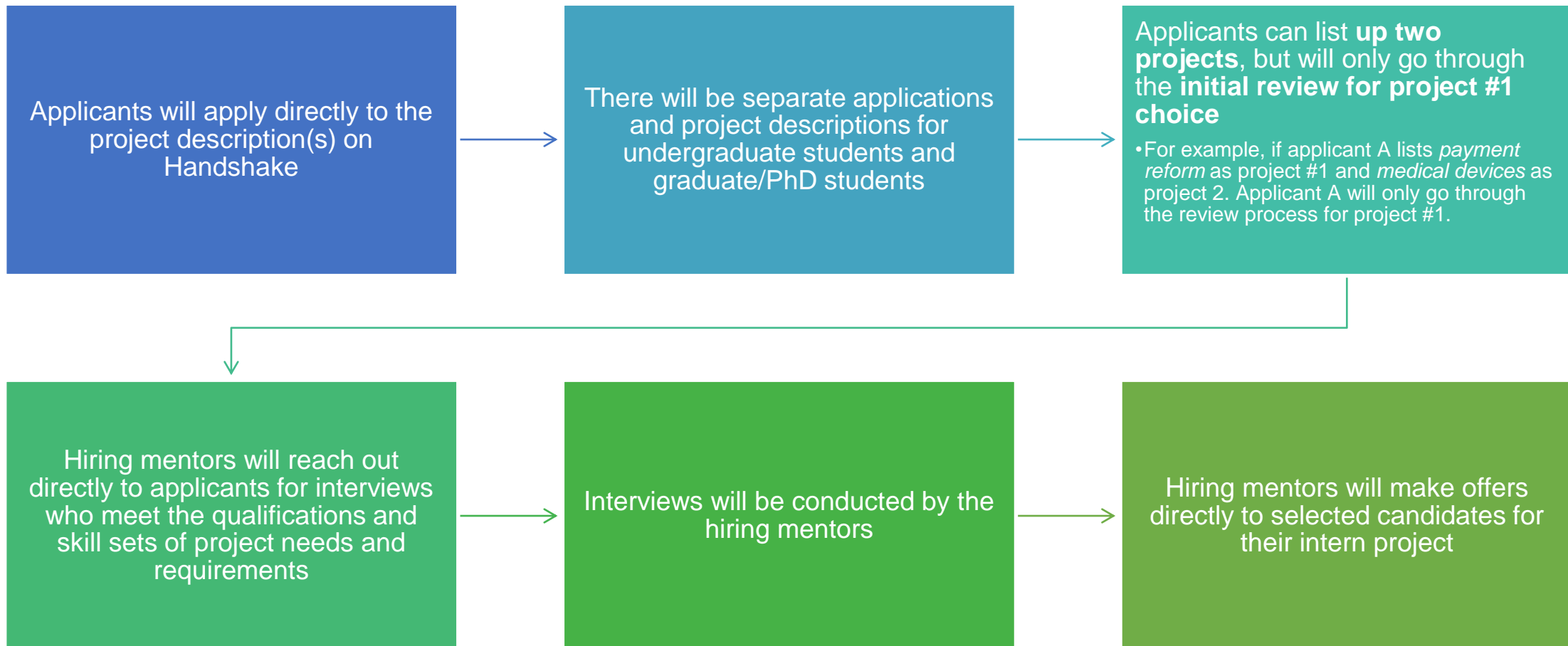
Program Details

- Internship Dates: May 22, 2023-July 28, 2023
- Approximately 40 hrs/week, paid internship
 - *\$15-16/hr rate for UG, \$17-18/hr rate for Grad students*
- Housing is not included in compensation packages
 - *Tip: most interns will sublease a place or use their networks to find a place to stay during the program*
 - *Duke University offers summer housing for both Duke and non-Duke students*
- The internship will be an in-person experience with some hybrid opportunities
- International students are eligible to apply

 - Unofficial Transcript
 - Statement of Interest
