





#### Sample Intern Pathway




### **Program Details**

- Internship Dates: May 22, 2023-July 28, 2023
- Approximately 40 hrs/week, paid internship
  - \$15-16/hr rate for UG, \$17-18/hr rate for Grad students
- Housing is not included in compensation packages
  - Tip: most interns will sublease a place or use their networks to find a place to stay during the program
  - Duke University offers summer housing for both Duke and non-Duke students
- The internship will be an in-person experience with some hybrid opportunities
- International students are eligible to apply

- Application will open Wednesday, January 4, 2023 and close at 5:00pm on Monday, February 6, 2023
- Materials to submit:
  - CV/ Resume
  - Unofficial Transcript
  - Statement of Interest
- All project descriptions will be posted on Handshake
