## VENUE: DUKE IN DC OFFICES

1201 Pennsylvania Ave 5<sup>th</sup> Floor Washington, DC 20004

When you enter the building, please walk toward the front desk. The security staff at the front desk will have a list of all confirmed in-person attendees and will provide access to the elevators. Upon exiting the elevator on the 5th floor, turn right and you will see the entrance to the Duke office.

# **GETTING THERE**

### DIRECTIONS

#### BY METRO

The Duke in DC office is easily accessible via public transportation.

- Metro Center (Red, Orange, Blue, and Silver Lines): Exit the station at 12th and F St. NW. Head South toward the National Mall. At the corner of 12th St. and Pennsylvania Ave. NW turn right. Building Entrance on Right: 1201 Pennsylvania Ave. NW.
- Federal Triangle (Orange, Blue, and Silver Lines): Exit the station at 12th St. NW. Turn left, heading North. Cross Pennsylvania Ave. NW and turn left. Building Entrance on Right: 1201 Pennsylvania Ave. NW.
- Archives-Navy Memorial-Penn Quarter (Green and Yellow Lines): Exit the station and head NW with Pennsylvania Ave. NW on your left and the memorial on your right. Cross 12th St. NW. Building Entrance on Right: 1201 Pennsylvania Ave. NW.

#### FROM MONTGOMERY COUNTY

- Take River Road south to Goldsboro Road and turn Right.
- Turn Left onto Massachusetts Avenue.
- Take Massachusetts Ave NW to 11th St NW in Washington
- Turn right onto 11th St NW
- Turn right onto Pennsylvania Avenue NW
- Turn right at the 1st cross street onto 12th St NW
- Destination will be on the left
- Upon arrival, take the elevators up to the 5<sup>th</sup> floor and follow the signs for the Duke University Offices

#### FROM VIRGINIA

#### I-395 NORTH

- Take I-395 N to 12th St Expy in Washington. Take the 12th St exit from I-395 N
- Use the 2nd from the right lane to take the 12th St exit toward L'Enfant Prom
- Continue on 12th St Expy. Drive to 12th St NW
- Keep left to continue on 12th St Expy
- Continue straight onto 12th St NW
- 1201 Pennsylvania Avenue NW Washington, DC 20004
- Parking available on E street in the rear of the building
- Upon arrival, take the elevators up to the 5<sup>th</sup> floor and follow the signs for the Duke University Offices

#### I-66

- Merge onto I-66 E
- Use the right 2 lanes to take the US-50 E exit toward Constitution Ave/Downtown
- Continue on US-50 E/Constitution Ave. NW. Drive to 12th St NW
- Continue onto US-50 E/Constitution Ave. NW
- Turn left onto 12th St NW
- Destination will be on the left
- Upon arrival, take the elevators up to the 5<sup>th</sup> floor and follow the signs for the Duke University Offices

#### FROM BALTIMORE

- Take I-95 S to I-495 S
- Baltimore-Washington Pkwy to State Hwy 295 to 12th St Expy in Washington.
- Take the Maine Ave exit from I-395 S
- Use the right lane to take the Maine Ave exit
- Use the right lane to take the 12th St ramp
- Continue on 12th St Expy. Drive to 12th St NW
- Merge onto 12th St Expy
- Continue straight onto 12th St NW Destination will be on the left
- 1201 Pennsylvania Avenue NW Washington, DC 20004
- Upon arrival, take the elevators up to the 5<sup>th</sup> floor and follow the signs for the Duke University Offices

#### PARKING

Paid parking is available in the rear of the 1201 Pennsylvania Ave. NW via E Street. Two garages are conveniently located either in or adjacent to the Duke in DC Office; managed by <u>One Parking</u> and <u>PMI</u>.
